<p>Panel Chair Recruitment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Update included outline of process including two nominated Panel Members on the interview Panel. Interviews have taken place with a nomination expected to be sent to the Authority after 23 September 2019. ▪ Appointment will be two years from January 2020 with a handover from current Chair before that.
<p>Panel Feedback</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Feedback was sought from Panel Members with a review of results next month.
<p>Ofgem/BEIS Consultation on reforming the energy industry Codes</p>	<p>PG provided a brief update on the Joint Office response to the consultation, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Joint Office has indicated that the IGT UNC and UNC could form one combined code for gas ▪ A strategic body is required that doesn't sit either within Ofgem or National Grid ETSO ▪ The strategic body should have wide ranging representation including Ofgem. <p>Ofgem/BEIS will respond within 12 weeks.</p> <p>Results of the Cross-code survey, undertaken by Future Thinking for Ofgem, should be published by end September 2019.</p>
<p>Ofgem Update on decision for Modification 0678 and alternatives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ofgem and CEPA presented at NTSCMF on 03 September 2019 focussing on the methodology to support the Impact Assessment. Ofgem expects to be able to give a minded-to position by the end of 2019 for 0678 and its alternatives and possibly for Modification 0686 too.
