# Why change?



- The references in the UNC to Data Protection Act 1998 need to be amended to Data Protection Act 2018 to reflect the introduction of EU General Data Protection Regulations 2018

# Options



- **Do nothing.**
  - Leaving the references unchanged would do not affect the fact the law has changed and Parties need to comply with UK law but would not be helpful.
- **Remove all reference to Data Protection Act**
  - This is an option and would remove what are, arguably, un-necessary references to the Data Protection Act.
  - This could not be done as Fast Track Self-Governance
- **Raise a Fast Track Self-Governance modification to change the references**

# Solution



- The following references to the Data Protection Act 1998 should be replaced with Data Protection Act 2018:
  - TPD G 2.1.13,
  - TPD V 5.3.4,
  - IGTAD F 5.1.3.

# Recommended Steps



- The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:
  - Subject to Fast Track self-governance because
    - it meets the self-governance criteria; and
    - it is a housekeeping modification required to update the reference to the Data Protection Act in three places in Code.
