## 2. November 2021 Major Release

# 2.1. XRN4780 - Part C - Inclusion of Meter Asset Provider Identity (MAP Id)

Simon Harris (SH) presented a summary of the Design Pack representations.

3 Representations were received, some seeking clarifications about the design and responses were provided by Xoserve.

Kirsty Dudley (KD) confirmed she was satisfied with the solution but expressed some concern about the availability of reporting. SH briefly explained the change and plans for reporting. Claire-Louise Roberts (CLR) also fed comment with regards to the availability of reporting and MAP data.

#### 3. Any Other Business

#### 3.1. CSSC Risk Discussion

James Rigby (JR) wished to flag that a CSSC options paper had been published on the 04 May for consideration at the 12 May 2021 DSC Change Management Committee Meeting at: <a href="https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/dsc-change/120521">https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/dsc-change/120521</a>. JR recommended the Committee reviewed the publication ahead of next week's meeting and to raise any questions. JR briefly explained that Xoserve have undertaken a risk assessment around the November 21 Major release, with relation to CSSC. Two BERs have been published, one with a full scope and one with a reduced scope, with the recommendation to descope the release.

Tracy O'Connor (TOC) further explained that following the impact assessment, it was recommended to proceed with 4 of the 6 changes in scope. There were 2 elements within XRN4941 with a greater impact, therefore the recommendation is to remove it from the scope. Whereas XRN5091 has a significant impact against CSSC so the recommendation is to proceed with this change once CSSC has gone live.

KD expressed concern that the Committee had just approved the Design Packs for XRNs 4941 and 5091 with an indicative date for November 21 release and questioned why these had been put forward. KD challenged the value of asking Shippers to approve the Design if there was a plan to descope from November 21 release.

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Paul Orsler (PO) explained that there was a need to better understand the impacts, the design would still remain the same, however Xoserve wished to present two options to either deliver the changes as planned with an alternative option to deliver most of the changes but delay those that would impact the CSSC programme.

Oorlagh Chapman (OC) asked if there was more information available, in particular to understanding all of the risks and subsequent decisions and recommendations to descope. PO explained a CSSC options had been published at <a href="https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/dsc-change/120521">https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/dsc-change/120521</a> and that this discussion was aimed at raising awareness for the discussion to be held at the 12 May meeting.

Claire Louise Roberts (CLR) enquired what the outcome would be if there was a decision to proceed as planned without delaying some of the changes. TOC explained that having looked at the various options it would not be possible to deliver all of the changes without impacting the CSSC programme.

Richard Pomroy (RP) wished for the Committee to note that the Distribution Network Operators have licence obligations to ensure Xoserve deliver CSSC on time and wished to stress that the risks/ impact to CSSC is not solely a project delivery concern due to the significance of the change programme.

KD enquired about the testing and market trials, expressing she was nervous, with the intricate design of MAP-C changes, implementation of the changes without trials when considering recent issues and the potential for defects. KD wanted more transparency of what will and will not be tested from a market perspective, particularly where there were multiple facets such as the November release and associated CSSC programme impacts.

TOC explained that currently the MAP-C is not within the scope of the November 21 release, this is running alongside the release. However, market trials can be considered and they welcomed views on the testing requirements should the industry want to further explore these options.

Further discussion is expected on 12 May.

Before concluding discussions, KD wished to highlight Change Proposal 4708C in relation to the implementation date in SPAA, noting that a proposal is currently being worked on to provide the industry better transparency and may offer benefits for data management in the DSC arrangements.
