2. Review of Single Year Modelling Results – Small and Large NDM (2021/22 data)

Mark Perry (MP) noted that Prepayment Meters generally have a flatter profile, and this was highlighted in previous years. In this modelling whilst this issue has been addressed MP highlighted this for when the profiles are shared with the wider industry, particularly in light of the higher price cap.

Dan Stenson (DS) thanked MP for flagging this.

Small NDM Domestic Conclusions:

Simon Geddes (SG) asked whether the outliers around customer behaviours could impact Unidentified Gas (UIG). MP explained that this was difficult to identify as a lot of UIG resulted because of NDM modelling. MP noted the NDM allocation is primarily because of high Annual Quantity (AQ) but highlighted this was steadily decreasing.

SG suggested that the decrease in AQ may possibly be related to the price cap increase. SG asked if anyone has identified any discrepancy between UIG and UGR.

MP explained that once the number of sites with AQs are shared, it can be identified how many meter points have been reconciled. MP added at present, it appears that around 3 million sites have not had their AQ reconciled, which will be part of the news article that will be shared.

SG asked if more UIG was expected, whether the UIG allocations were acceptable. MP explained that the UIG weighting factors differ for different UIGs and the process is managed by the Allocation of Unidentified Gas Expert (AUGE). MP added that these weighting factors are outside the scope of DESC and the 2023 AUG weighting factors have now been approved and published.

MP noted that AQ is the key input for NDM estimation and it is always out of date as any change in customer behaviour is not reflected in AQ for a few months. MP suggested that the best way to get the new base level is by meter reads rather than AQ.

Joe Lloyd (JL) stated that the recent call by Martin Lewis for domestic customers to submit their meter reads by 31 March 2022 had seen 2.5m AQs being affected.

Small NDM I&C

PG presented the small NDM I&C data for consumption band EUCs.

PG asked the Committee to vote on the two options available for the 03W01-04 and 04W01-04 WAR Band Summary. The Committee Members unanimously voted for Option 1, which was the recommended option.

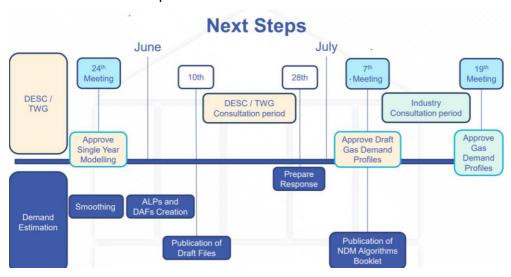
