Gas Charging Discussion 13 - Draft

Discussion on the impacts of Existing Contracts on Transmission Services Reference Prices

- As highlighted over recent NTSCMFs, National Grid propose to issue a Charging Discussion Document on which the purpose is to gather views on several key areas of Gas Transportation Charging
 - The ongoing impacts and influence of Existing Contracts in the Transmission Services Entry charges
 - Options to review overall Transmission Services Entry charges considering the decision not to implement UNC0790 and expectation to review further the impact of Existing Contracts.
 - Whilst focused on Transmission Services Entry charging, this paper also invites comments on some broader perspectives and whether further review would be beneficial under a separate discussion topic (e.g. reviewing the split between Entry and Exit charging).
- **This document is a draft**, for discussion only and an opportunity to provide some comments to help refine, and we are looking to issue in **February 2023**
- We are looking for Stakeholder input in shaping and refining the options considered
- Views on this draft will be captured and incorporated into the final document to help ensure:
