

APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO MODIFY THE UNIFORM NETWORK CODE

"0013a(0740a) : Amendment to Transco's rights to interrupt for supply / demand purposes"
Version 1.0

Transporters Proposal:

Modification Proposal 0013a (740a) was approved by Ofgem on the 11/07/2005 with an effective implementation date 01/10/2005.

As a result of correspondence from a User it has been noted that the original legal text as contained within the Final Modification Report v2.0, which was approved by Ofgem, and the subsequent Notice of Implementation v1.0, may require some clarity when amending the UNC and that one particular aspect may require a change through a Consent to Modify.

Nature of Modification:

The following consent is required:-

1. **Consent to Modify** - Section G6.10.4 (c) and G6.11.4 reference to 'Transco' should be amended to 'the Transporter'.
2. **Point of Clarification** - all text within G6.10.4 (a), (b), and (c) is to remain in the UNC. As part of the legal text for this Proposal paragraph (a) does not reference to entire paragraph and does not provide the indication that it continues i.e '.....'.

Proposed amendments to the Legal text as extracted from the Notice of Implementation, as follows:-

"Delete G6.7.3 (c),

"In any Day in respect of which, at any time, Forecast Total System Demand exceeds 85% of System 1-in-20 peak day demand."

Amend paragraph 6.10.4 to read as follows:

"Where ~~Transco~~ the Transporter requires Interruption at the Supply Point:

(a) in any period of 60 minutes in the Day, and subject always to paragraph 5.3.1 and to the provisions of any relevant Network Exit Agreement, the Registered User will be allowed to offtake a quantity of gas ...;

(b) for the purposes . . . ; and

(c) the provisions of"

Amend paragraph 6.11.4 to read as follows:

"Where ~~Fransco~~ the Transporter requires Interruption at an Interruptible CSEP:

(a) in any period of 60 minutes in the Day, and subject always to paragraph 5.3.1 and to the provisions of any relevant Network Exit Agreement, the CSEP User will be allowed to offtake a quantity of gas. . . ;

(b) for the purposes . . . where the hourly offtake in paragraph (i) has been exceeded; and

(c) the provisions of"
