Transporter Proposal

The Joint Office of Gas Transporters would like to request that the Authority grant permission to amend the legal text as contained within the Notice of Implementation 0046 and its associated Consent to Modify C015 to take into account the renumbering of the paragraphs in UNC Section TDIIC 1.1 by the previous implementation of 0043, effective 06:00hrs on 05 October 2005 within UNC update 1.02, Code as at 01 December 2005.

In summary, the prior implementation of 0043 inserted a new paragraph 1.1, including sub paragraph 1.1.1 and renumbered the existing paragraph 1.1.1 as 1.1.2. This now means that the numbering contained within the Notice of Implementation 0046 needs to be incremented up one for each paragraph, as highlighted below.

Nature of Modification

Legal text as extracted from the Notice of Implementation 0046 v1.0, effective 06:00hrs 23 January 2006, and its associated Consent to Modify C015, to be amended as highlighted below:

"<u>1.1 TPD Section B : SYSTEM USE AND CAPACITY</u>

Amend the following new paragraphs to paragraph 1.1.1:

<u>1.1.31.1.2</u> <u>TPD Section B6.3.2(b)</u>

A DNO User may apply for an amount of NTS Offtake Capacity at an NTS/LDZ Offtake in relation to the relevant Gas Year ending 30 September 2009 by submitting an application to Transco NTS no later than 15 October 2005 subject to and in accordance with TPD Section B6.

<u>1.1.41.1.3</u> TPD Section B6.3.6

In the case of an application under paragraph 1.1.2, Transco NTS will notify the DNO User by no later than 12 November 2005 whether such application has been accepted in whole or in part, or rejected, specifying (where the application is accepted in part) the amount of NTS (Flat) Capacity and /or NTS Offtake (Flexibility) Capacity for which the application is accepted.

<u>1.1.51.1.4</u> TPD Section B 6.2.1

Transco NTS will issue to each of the DNO Users not later than 12 November 2005 a revised Offtake Capacity Statement specifying the amount of NTS Offtake (Flat) Capacity, NTS (Flexibility) Capacity and Assured Offtake Pressures for each of the DNO Users for each of the

<u>Gas Years up to and including the Gas Year ending 30 September 2009</u> in relation to each NTS/LDZ Offtake."
