Revision Notification

Northern Triangle impact on Available Capacity only

Transfer and Trade System Entry Capacity (TTSEC) Auction

Invitation to participate in auction for Monthly NTS Entry Capacity for period November 2007 to March 2008

Dear Colleague

With regard to the invitation to participate in the TTSEC auction issued on 25th September please be advised that we have identified some data anomalies in Table 5 - Available Monthly Capacity for Each ASEP Zone of the original letter. The discrepancy has arisen due to the totals for Northern Triangle being calculated using the original Zonal Allocation Maximum (ZAM) and not the revised numbers calculated after the surrender process had completed.

Therefore the amount of Available Monthly Capacity published for the Northern Triangle has been recalculated and is shown in bold in the table below.

Revised Table 5 – Available Monthly Capacity for Each ASEP Zone

Important: 50% of the Available Monthly Capacity will be available in each Tranche of the auction with any unallocated capacity from the first Tranche being rolled over to the second Tranche.
