

Proposed Revision to the System Management Principles Statement
Consultation by Wales and West Utilities

Summary

"Standard Special Condition D5 paragraph 7(a) of Wales & West Utilities (WWU's) gas transporter licence requires us to review the System Management Principles Statement (SMPS) and to consult the industry.
