Agenda Item 3.0: Adhoc Workplan Update

- DESC reviewed the topics that are due to receive some focus in the coming autumn/winter period following approval of the Adhoc workplan priorities in July.

One key area of focus is the Domestic Prepayment Profile (“01BPD”) which, in the absence of an upto date sample view of daily gas consumption data, continues to be based on a historic demand model that is now approaching nearly 10 years old. DESC confirmed this End User Category (EUC) is a priority going forwards and will continue to review all possible options when considering the production of Gas Demand Profiles for Gas Year 2022/23. Agenda Item 6.0: UIG Allocation Issues Tracker

- Following discussions at Performance Assurance Committee (PAC) about recent spikes in the D+1 LDZ Unidentified Gas (UIG) Allocation, it has been agreed that a tracker will be set up and maintained to enable the industry to view historical issues. This record should help customers understand any unusual spikes and dips in historical UIG when performing analysis of trends. A prototype of the tracker was reviewed and approved by DESC and this will be available on the Xoserve website shortly.
