1.0 Introduction and Status Review

1.1. Approval of minutes (06 December 2018)

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

2.0 Review of Actions

There were no outstanding actions.

3.0 Consideration of Amended Modification

Malcolm Montgomery (MM) provided a brief walkthrough of a draft amended version of Modification provided by Colin Hamilton on 07 January 2019, provided for discussion only. Workgroup noted that the late publication did not allow for Industry consideration in advance of the meeting.

MM explained that this was not an amended version of the Modification but simply some proposed changes for discussion. He invited Workgroup to provide comments over the next couple of weeks so that National Grid can formally propose an amended version for discussion at the February meeting. In addition, he suggested that the amended version will also take account, where relevant, of any required changes to reflect the new charging Modification that would replace UNC 0621.

In particular, he stated that the draft includes more detail in the Solution section within the sub-heading *High Level view of the assessment process* in relation to the process to allow people to apply for status for capacity. MM said that in relation to storage sites within a large Aggregated System Entry Point (ASEP) one of the questions National Grid are trying to address is how to identify if capacity has been purchased for storage or not.

In response to a question from Bill Reed (BR) in relation to whether there is any connection with Forecasted Contracted Capacity (FCC), Rebecca Hailes (RH) reiterated that, as this question is related to the UNC 0621 discussion, it should be raised at the NTSCMF meeting on 10 January 2019.

Graham Jack (GJ) also asked if UNC 0662 is still considered to be fit for purpose given the dependency on what is proposed, following rejection of UNC 0621 and asked whether there are any plans to include this in any new proposal? MM indicated that UNC 0662 is regarded to be a capacity issue and not a charging issue, so it is unlikely to be included as part of any new Modification related to charging and will continue to be a separate Modification.

MM in response to a question from GJ also suggested that the timescales set out within the Modification would need to be reviewed.

RH confirmed that the next steps would be to consider the amended Modification and develop the Workgroup report.
