

## MODIFICATION PROPOSAL

Date: 15th March 1996

Proposed implementation date: As soon as possible.

Urgency: URGENT

Justification: As a result of limited participation by Users in the flexibility mechanism and volumes of beach gas required to address imbalances not being available (and storage gas being used in greater quantities than anticipated), it is expected that the £10 million flexibility mechanism cap for March will be breached by 16th March. Some Users have made it known to TransCo that they do not want the flexibility mechanism to be suspended.

### AREA OF NETWORK CODE CONCERNED

Transition Document, Section 4, Energy Balancing, paragraph 4.2.2

### NATURE OF PROPOSAL

It is proposed that the table of Amounts be amended in paragraph 4.2.2 as reflected below, and there be an additional column specifying the maximum rate of net Balancing Neutrality Charges (referred to in paragraph 4.2.1) recovery:

If the net Balancing Neutrality Charges exceed the maximum Recoverable Amount set out above, the under-recovered charges will be carried over to the next month.
