This communication is to provide an update on the progress of the 2012 AUGS for 2013/14 methodology.

The Consumption Analysis and Theft Interim Report has been sent to the Joint Office of Transporters for publication on their website. The issues with the theft split methodology have now been resolved and the analysis completed the findings can be found in the report.

The consultation period will run from 31st August to Friday 28th September and we welcome responses in writing to the AUGE mailbox, <u>AUGE@gl-group.com</u>. We will also be looking to arrange a meeting with industry representatives to present and discuss the analysis at a technical level and provide the opportunity to raise initial clarification questions.
