Problem Statement:	Currently RPC backing data files are issued in a variety of ways (email and dedicated portal) and this XRN is required to support the implementation of IGT173 so that the data can be issued via the IX.					
Change Description:	 Aligned to the business rules agreed in approved version IGT173 High-level requirements based on the initial draft (subject to change as the modification develops) – those highlighted in Blue relate to the aspects of the IGT Modification to which this Change Proposal would need to ensure delivery of – all other Business Rules relate to activity outside the remit of this Change Proposal: To mandate the IGTs to cascade the RPC data via the IX which includes node creation To mandate the Shippers to receive the RPC data via the IX [TBC if new node is required for shippers] To mandate the CDSP to support the IGTs and Shippers by sending the data between parties using the category 2 approach (acting as a post service only) For the CDSP to complete necessary steps to connect the IGTs and Shippers in a technical capacity (may not be required if all parties already have IX connections) For the CDSP to utilise the file name [RPC] to enable the IX to recognise the file format For the CDSP to utilise the file name to distribute to the correct Shipper For the Shippers to ingest the files issued by the IGT and delivered by the IX into their internal systems.
