Dear Colleague

The 1<sup>st</sup> draft 2013 AUGS for 2014/15 is now published for consultation which will end at 5pm on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2013 (42 days as per AUGE Guidelines).

The AUGS contains details of the analyses carried out in 2013 to investigate and address issues raised from the previous consultation. It contains a full description of the methodology which is based on the consumption method developed in 2012. The AUGS also includes the impact of approved modifications on Unidentified Gas that come into effect by 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014. The analyses have been carried out on existing data from 2012 with the addition of information on Multiple Meter Supply Points which will be posted on UK-link in due course.

The AUGE will attend and present a summary of the 1<sup>st</sup> Draft 2013 AUGS for 2014/15 at an industry meeting on Wednesday May 15<sup>th</sup>. As per previous years this is an opportunity for an initial Q&A session to clarify particular points set out in the AUGS before submitting consultation responses.

As we do not intend to publish consultation responses received until after the end of the consultation period we would appreciate it if you are able to submit your responses as early as possible. This would enable us to investigate issues raised as soon as possible, particularly those that may require additional data or analysis to resolve.
