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Smart Energy Code (SEC) Update

1. Purpose

This paper intends to inform the Uniform Network Code (UNC) Modification Panel and UNC Parties of the activities occurring in relation to the SEC.

2. Code Update

SEC 5.7 came into effect on 11th May 2017, implementing Modification Proposal <u>SECMP0033</u> <u>"Update to CH Handover Support Materials</u>".

SEC Appendix H: CH Handover Support Materials (CHHSM) provides information on how Communication Hubs (CHs) will work in the wider smart metering environment. More specifically, the CHHSM provides details in relation to ordering and installing CHs. SECMP0033 was raised to ensure that the CHHSM fully aligns with the solution the DCC have implemented.

This has resulted in a new defined term for a 'Service Management Service Request' and amendments to the Consignment Labelling and information table.

3. SEC Governance

3.1 Consultation on changing the end date of the Secretary of State Variations on the Self-Service Interface (SSI) functionality as defined in SEC Section H8.16(c)

At the May 2016 meeting, the SEC Panel were made aware that the DCC would shortly write to the SEC Panel Chair requesting that a consultation be undertaken with SEC Parties on changing the end date of the Secretary of State variation on the Self-Service Interface (SSI) functionality as defined in SEC Section H8.16(c)). The Panel agreed to issue a consultation on receipt of the request from the DCC.

The DCC formally requesting on 23rd May 2017 that the transitional variations end dates are changed, as they cannot meet the current end date of 30th June 2017.

4. SEC Modifications Update

4.1 New Modification Proposal

Since the May 2017 UNC Modification Panel meeting, three new Modification Proposals have been raised. This is outlined in Table one below.

SEC Modification Proposal	Summary of Modification
SECMP0036 – Single User ID for Users acting in one or more User Roles	This Modification proposes to enable a User to use the same User ID when operating in the roles of 'Import Supplier' and 'Gas Supplier'.
SECMP0037 – Pairing Local PPMIDs	This modification seeks to remove the 60 minute limit requirement that Communications Hub (CH) currently have to allow the Hand Held Terminal (HHT) to join the Home Area Network (HAN) after power on. This is to give Suppliers the option of providing Prepayment Meter Interface Devices (PPMIDs) to their Consumers, that can join a HAN without requiring a reliable Wide Area Network (WAN) connection or engineer intervention.
SECMP0038 – Sending Commands via PPMIDs	This modification seeks to offer the option for Prepayment Meter Interface Devices (PPMIDs) to be able to pass fully formed Great Britain Companion Specification (GBCS) Remote Party Commands onto the Home Area Network (HAN). It is expected that the Commands would usually be routed from the Supplier to the PPMID via Wi-Fi connectivity.

Table one: New Modification Proposals

The Initial Modification Reports for these new Modification Proposals will be considered by the Panel at the June 2017 meeting.

4.2 Approvals and Rejections

On 21st June 2017, the Change Board will vote on the following Path 3 'Self Governance Modification Proposal, following the conclusion on the Modification Report Consultation on 8th June 2017.

Path 3 – Self Governance:

• SECMP0035 – Updates to SEC Appendix B – Organisation ARL expiration date to be aligned to DCCKI ARL

Path 2 – Authority Determination:

On 2nd June 2017, the Authority (BEIS) issued three decision letters regarding the following Modification Proposals:

- SECMP0004: Inclusion of Device Serial Number data item in the Smart Metering Inventory –The Authority has sent back the modification for further work prior to reaching a determination. The Authority has also requested a revised implementation date in light of the indications from the DCC that they cannot implement Modification Proposals prior to 2019.
- SECMP0008: Provision of a DCC Alert (formerly Service Request Error Response) for Quarantined Service Requests – The Authority sent back the modification to request a

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revised implementation date in light of the indications from the DCC that they cannot implement Modification Proposals prior to 2019.

• SECMP0011: Including the MAP ID in the Smart Metering Inventory – The Authority issued a determination that SECMP0011 should not be made, and it is therefore closed.

The Panel will consider actions and next steps at the 9th June 2017 Panel meeting for SECMP0004 and SECMP0008.

4.3 Referred Change Board decision to the Panel

Following the Panel decision to uphold the outcome of the Change Board vote on **SECMP0021 'Increase Other SEC Party representation for TABASC and SSC'** at the May 2017 meeting, the Proposer (Landis and Gyr), an Other SEC Party, has referred the Panel decision to the Authority, in accordance with Section D9.4(b). The Authority consideration of the referral will inform the next steps on what happens with SECMP0021.
