0408S: Moffat and Bacton Interconnectors: Changes to Agreements to Align to UNC Modification 0195AV

Date referred from Panel: 15 December 2011

Background – Why Change?

Solution

Transportation arrangements between National Grid NTS and Shipper Users for the Interconnectors are primarily provided in the UNC, with some additional rules, specific to CSEPs, detailed in the relevant Ancillary Agreement (the "AA"), specifically the Moffat Ancillary Agreement (Amended and Restated CSEP Ancillary Agreement) GB-Ireland Interconnector, and the CSEP Ancillary Agreement UK-Continent Interconnector.

Additionally Network Exit Provisions are contained in the:

- Second Amendment and Restatement Agreement in respect of the Connected Systems Agreement (GB – Ireland Interconnector) between National Grid NTS and BGE (UK) Limited and
- Interconnection Agreement (UK-Continent Interconnector) between National Grid NTS and Interconnector (UK) Limited.

These Network Exit Provisions govern the way in which gas may be offtaken from the NTS at the CSEP and hence can have an effect on CSEP Users at the CSEP. These two agreements with the Interconnector Operators are referred to as the Connected System Agreements (the "CSA"s).

It is necessary that these four agreements are updated to be consistent with UNC Modification 0195AV.
