## **Change Management**

#### **UPCO003- IAD Transactional Charging**

- Change Order proposing a change to the method of charging for the IAD service from a charge per IAD account to a transactional based charge to be delivered in parallel with the existing IAD replacement system presented at September UPUC.
- Change Order approved following voting, and submitted to xoserve to prepare an Evaluation Quotation Report (EQR).
- EQR presented at November UPUC approved following voting.
- As requested BEO produced by xoserve, requesting production of BER.
- BER to be presented at UPUC
- Consultation period & UPUC member voting (as per UPUC ToR)

#### **ACS Review April 2011**

- The new ACS was submitted to Ofgem with the new Mod 279 report price on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2011
- The ACS review for April 2011 is ongoing
- Draft revised ACS and Review Report for 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 due to be published mid February for customers to review and feedback any comments they may have
- Discuss whether UPUC required in February to go through the report and ACS
