

AQs of 1 - statistics

Statistics with regards to AQs of 1

- In the Trial Calc 2017 270,784 SSP Meter Points failed to calculate a revised AQ owing to negative consumption.
- Following the July recalculation the AQ1 population was 352,852 (previously 306,846, circa 15% increase)
- Following the August recalculation the AQ1 population was 408,813 (33% increase from 01st June)
- Of the 352,852 in July, 76,055 have an AQ effective date of 1st July 2017 (new rolling AQ/time slice)
- Of the 76,055, 18,905 (25%) failed to calculate for Trial Calc 2017 owing to negative consumption, the other 75% are new AQs of 1
- It is difficult to determine what % are accurate AQs of 1 owing to static consumption, and which are erroneous owing to negative consumption.
