Protection from ratchet charges for Daily Metered customers with an AQ of 732,000kWh and below

# Why change?

 The ratchet regime currently applies to all Daily Metered sites in Classes 1 and 2

 Post-Nexus, this could include domestic and small consumers, should they opt to utilise DM equipment such as Smart Metering

## **Options**

 Small/domestic DM customers could be placed in Class 3 or 4, however this would not be consistent with the industry goal of enhanced, more granular data.

### Solution

- Sites with an AQ of 732,000kWh and below will be protected from the charging element of the regime
- The regime would remain in place for sites above this threshold

### Recommended Steps

- The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:
  - Not subject to self-governance as the proposal may have a material impact on the commercial activities connected with shipping gas, or commercial activities related to the shipping, transportation or supply of gas.
  - Sent to Workgroup assessment to develop the modification for 3 months.
