The Workgroup Report is due to be presented at the UNC Modification Panel by 21 March 2019.

1.0 Outline of Modification

Phil Lucas (PL) reiterated the background to the Modification and explained that a number of minor changes to the Uniform Network Code (UNC) were required as a consequence of the United Kingdom (UK) withdrawal from the European Union (EU) which becomes effective from 23:00 on 29th March 2019 where there is a no deal scenario. The changes modify existing references to EU regulations and replaces them with a reference to UK amendment regulations and statutory instruments, and where appropriate remove references to EU entities.

He said that this Modification had been fully discussed within the March Distribution Workgroup and there had been no change in the content or context of Modification itself since

it was discussed in this Workgroup in February as a pre Modification. Panel had determined it was suitable to be of a Self-Governance status.

He explained that the Statutory Instruments had now be through the parliamentary assessment and had been approved.

He said that the Modification would subsequently be submitted to the March Panel with the assumption it would then be sent out to consultation.
