We would like to provide comments on the level of transparency provided by National Grid in the UNC Mod 0675 process. The Bacton IP exit will undergo significant operational change to provide further optionality and flexibility to shippers once BBL reverse flow becomes live, however we believe more transparency is required to ensure that the full benefits of this project are realised with minimal disruption. We would welcome further information and analysis from National Grid to confirm that there is no discrimination between shippers at Bacton, i.e. ensuring other Bacton shippers will not face additional costs or operational issues as a result of the newly proposed provisions within the BBL-NTS interconnection agreement.
