We are not entirely convinced of the need for the change as this appears to have been based only upon a subjective assessment of the potential impact of the current terminology, with little objective evidence having been advanced. Moreover, the change also appears largely targeted at public/media perception, rather than industry parties who should have a greater understanding of the underlying significance of the notifications, and as such the impact on the Relevant Objectives is difficult to assess. That having been said we offer qualified support if the wider belief is that the new wording is less capable of misinterpretation beyond industry circles.
