This modification has been raised following development work carried out within 0646R Review of the Offtake Arrangements Document (OAD) workgroup as the OAD has broadly remained unchanged since inception. National Grid considers that the Modification furthers the Relevant Objective f) Promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the Code by providing clarity in the UNC regarding the requirements as mentioned below.

- Site Security: under certain scenarios the expectation is that the Site User will be responsible for site security, current OAD obligations currently prohibits this and therefore a change and clarity to the existing obligations is required.
- Closed NTS to LDZ site and Shared sites (no offtake): this provides definitions
 and clarity when these sites in exceptional circumstances may be required to flow
 gas.
- Incorporation of the new OAD Template Agreement document will enable Connection Facilities and other assets to be documented in line with Workgroup discussions.
- Tripartite Sites: enables the site services party to sign onto the Supplemental Agreement when there are multiple Site Users at an Offtake site.
