**TRANSITION DOCUMENT**

**PART VI – TEMPORARY MEASURES**

*Amend paragraph 3.5 to read as follows:*

3.5 TPD Section G3.7 shall not apply in relation to a Relevant Supply Meter Point which is deemed to be Isolated in accordance with paragraph 3.3, provided the Relevant Supply Meter Point shall cease to be deemed to be Isolated with effect from the earlier of:

- (a) the date on which the Transporter or the CDSP becomes aware gas is being offtaken from the Total System at the Relevant Supply Meter Point in quantities which exceed the de minimus quantity;
- (b) the end of the Relevant Period

(and the CDSP will promptly update the Supply Point Register to remove the Isolated status).

*Insert new paragraphs 3.7, 3.8, 3.9 and 3.10 to read as follows:*

3.7 Where a Supply Meter Point is deemed Isolated in accordance with this paragraph 3 where the Registered User confirms the Supply Meter Point is a Relevant Supply Meter Point in accordance with paragraph 3.9 the Registered User shall be entitled to a rebate equal to fifty per cent (50%) of the LDZ Capacity Charge in respect of the Relevant Supply Meter Point for each Day in the rebate period.

3.8 For the purposes of paragraph 3.7:

(a) "rebate period" is the period:

(i) commencing, in the case of a Relevant Supply Meter Point which is deemed Isolated:

(1) on a date preceding the implementation date, the implementation date; or

(2) on or on a date following the implementation date, the date on which it was deemed Isolated; and

(ii) ending on the date the Relevant Supply Meter Point ceases to be deemed Isolated in accordance with paragraph 3.5;

(b) "implementation date" is the date on which the Code Modification known as Modification 0730 is implemented.

3.9 Where a Supply Meter Point is deemed Isolated in accordance with this paragraph 3:

(a) the CDSP shall request the Registered User to confirm the Supply Meter Point is a Relevant Supply Meter Point;

(b) the Registered User must submit any such confirmation by notice to the CDSP within twenty (20) Supply Point Systems Business days of receipt of the CDSP's request under paragraph (a).

and by submitting such confirmation the Registered User warrants that in relation to the Supply Meter Point the circumstances referred to in paragraph 3.1(a) or (b) apply.
