

## UNC Workgroup Individual Terms of Reference

### 0625S - Extension of 6 months to 12 months to transfer non-mandatory sites from Class 1

#### Introduction

This is an Individual Terms of Reference that includes matters referred from Panel or identified within any initial representations. It replaces the standard Terms of Reference.

#### Purpose of the Modification and its Solution

It is proposed to extend the current **6 month** deadline for moving non mandatory DM sites from Class 1 to **12 months** to address delays caused by ongoing issues relating to Class 1 sites following NEXUS Go Live thus allowing for an orderly transfer of arrangements.

#### Topics for Discussion

- Understanding the objective
- Assessment of alternative means to achieve objective
- Development of Solution (including business rules if appropriate)
- Assessment of potential impacts of the modification
- Assessment of implementation costs
- Assessment of legal text.

#### Referred from Panel for consideration

The Workgroup is asked to consider the following:

- to validate the extension period of 6 months and explain why this is appropriate
- to quantify the number of sites and volumes impacted by the proposals

#### Output

To produce a Workgroup Report, for submission to the UNC Modification Panel, containing the assessment and recommendation(s) of the Workgroup.

#### Composition of Workgroup

The Workgroup is open to any party that wishes to attend or participate.

A Workgroup meeting will be quorate provided at least two Transporter and two Shipper User representatives are present.
