

Summary of Key Messages from DESC on 6th July 2020

Outcomes

2.0 Review DESC / TWG responses to draft Gas Demand Profiles (for Gas Year 2020/21)

- DESC discussed the CDSP's response to the comments raised on the first draft of this year's Gas Demand Profiles for Gas Year 2020/21. DESC were satisfied with the explanations given and as a result DESC agreed that the profiles could be released for wider industry review with the usual 5 business day consultation period.

Any industry comments raised will be discussed at the next DESC meeting on 22nd July, which is when the profiles should become final.

3.0 Seasonal Normal Review update

- DESC were presented with the draft Seasonal Normal End User Category (EUC) Ratios. These ratios will be applied against those Supply Meter Points which fail to calculate an AQ in September with a 1st October 2020 effective date. The ratios are due to be finalised at the next DESC meeting on 22nd July when this year's EUC Demand modelling process should be concluded.
