Agenda Item 1.7 User Representative Appointment Process

Agenda Item 2.0: 2022/23 NDM Algorithms – Review Industry Representations

- Following DESC's invitation to the wider industry to comment on the draft Gas Demand Profiles for Gas Year 2022/23 as part of the formal industry consultation, we can confirm there were **no additional industry representations** received.

DESC voted to approve the latest draft profiles which means the industry consultation has been completed for this year. Ofgem will now be informed.

- The remaining activities will focus on updating the core industry systems such as UK Link and Gemini during August and September.

Agenda Item 4.0 Seasonal Normal Review 2025

- DESC kicked off early discussions for the new Seasonal Normal review cycle which includes a potential procurement exercise for a revised Climate Change Methodology. There will be opportunities in future meetings at DESC to get involved in this piece of work once the process and timetable has been agreed – due to be discussed at the DESC meeting in October.
