Objective of UNCC Today

- Fulfil the Committee's UNC obligation to consider the final AUG Table of UIG Weighting Factors
- UNC E9.4.3: In respect of each AUG Year:
 - i.e. the AUG Framework Document*
 - (g) such steps as are set out in the **AUG Document** shall be taken in relation to the proposed AUG Table, following which the AUG Expert shall submit a final AUG Table to the Committee for approval;
 - (h) the Committee shall approve the final AUG Table submitted by the AUG Expert pursuant to paragraph (g) **unless by unanimous resolution** the Committee determines:
 - (i) **to approve a modified AUG Table**; or
 - (ii) **to require any further iteration of any steps as referred to in paragraph (g)**, in which case paragraph (g) and this paragraph (h) shall further apply;
 - (i) the Committee shall publish the AUG Table approved in accordance with paragraph (h);

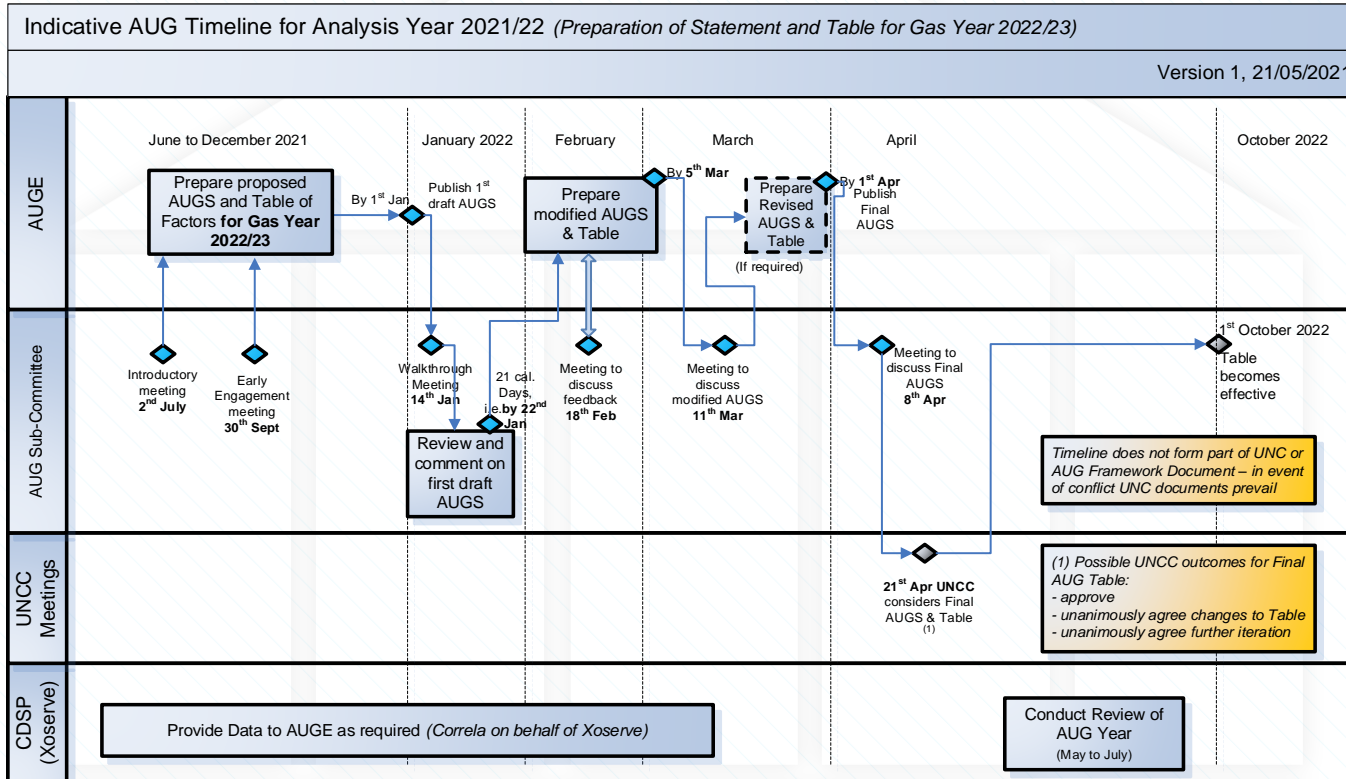

Background

- AUG Expert defines a Methodology (an AUG Statement – “AUGS”) to determine weighting factors to be used for distribution of daily UIG rather than a total UG quantity
- Rules set out in UNC E9
- AUGE does not set or determine the daily level of UIG
- Detailed process steps in UNC Related Document (the “Framework”) <https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/tpddocs>
- Fourth year of operation of the revised process (as developed in Review Group 0639)
- Second year of outputs of new AUGE (appointed in June 2020)

Early engagement meeting in Sept/Oct	Held 30th September
Publish first draft AUGS and Table by 31 December	Published 22nd December
First draft AUGS Walkthrough – target 15 Jan	Held 14th January 2022
Review of draft AUGS feedback meeting – target 15 Feb	Held 18th February
Walkthrough of revised draft AUGS and Table – target 12 March	Held 11th March
Publish Final AUGS and Table by 31 March	Published 31st March
Walkthrough of Final AUGS and Table - target 5 days prior to April UNCC	Held 8th April

Status of UNC Modification 0782

- Modification 0782 “Creation of Independent AUGE Assurer (IAA) role” raised by Corona in September 2021
- Seeks to appoint a new independent body to “oversee the activities of the AUGE”
- In response to concerns Xoserve has conducted an audit of its management of the AUGE for the 2021/22 service
- One of the Audit recommendations is that Xoserve procures its own independent annual review of the AUGE’s compliance
- Xoserve has now defined an outline scope for this review service, which is included in the updated Audit Report

- Mod 0782 was withdrawn 08/04/2022 based on the Xoserve proposal for an independent review

Options for April UNCC meeting

- Unanimously agree changes to Final AUG Table published 31 March
<https://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/AUGStatement2223>
 - Final Table is included in the AUG Statement – page 5 of the document
 - **Chair Question: “Does any party propose any changes to the Table?”** – if so, vote on the proposal – **requires unanimous agreement**
- Or:
- Unanimously agree a further iteration of one or more steps in the AUG Framework document
 - **Chair Question: “Does any party propose any such re-work?”** – if so, vote on the proposal – **requires unanimous agreement**
- **Otherwise the AUG Table is approved**
 - Becomes effective 1 October 2022

Annual Review of the AUG Year

- AUG Framework includes a CDSP obligation to consult industry on “*activities and performance of the AUG Expert and industry for the creation of the AUG Statement and Table*” and produce a report the Committee
- Proposed timetable for review of 2021/22 process:
 - Launch review at May UNCC and issue request for Feedback via Joint Office mailing list: **19 May**
 - Closing date for feedback (3 weeks): **10 June**
 - Present completed report at UNCC: **21 July**
