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# UNC Modification

IUK is seeking to develop and offer a fast-cycle, low volume Storage Service to the GB market using its existing infrastructure.

- A UNC Modification is being developed by National Grid to facilitate the offer of a Storage Service at Interconnectors connected to the NTS.
- The modification will allow Interconnector Storage Users to be treated in a similar manner to Users of other Storage Facilities.
- Transportation services remain IUK's priority and will remain unimpacted.



# Why offer an additional Storage Service?

**An additional Storage Service enables IUK to offer additional flexibility services to the GB market during periods of low transportation utilisation.**

- IUK's Storage Service would be accessed by IUK Storage Users at Bacton only.
- IUK Storage Users will have access to the variable inventory capability of the IUK system to act on short-term fluctuations in the price of gas at the NBP.
- As with other GB Storage Facilities, Users would benefit from the specific NG Charging arrangements applicable at NTS connections to Storage Facilities.
- The required legal and regulatory processes are underway, and IUK will provide more details on the commercial aspects of the IUK Storage Service in due course.
