Impact

- For Missing Messages, the Switching Operator has indicated that they cannot generate the Secured Active Message
- UNC envisages that we will get formal Secured Active Synch messages, and references 'Notifications' as a term from the REC

(d) **Definitive Registration Notification** means:

- (i) in relation to a Registration Request, a Notification sent to the CDSP that the Registration Request is Secured Active as described in paragraphs 5.2.3(f)(i) and 5.2.3(f)(ii);

	means a type of Market Message, as described in the Switching Data Management Schedule.

- The Code does state that we are **not required** to accept messages other than those specified in the REC

(c) the CDSP shall not be required to act on any communication from the CSS Provider which is not in accordance with the REC or in compliance with any CSS Process;
