

UNC Variation Request

0664V – Transfer of Sites with Low Valid Meter Reading Submission Performance from Classes 2 and 3 into Class 4

Date: 12 November 2020

The Proposer, SSE (Mark Jones), requests a variation to this Modification, pursuant to UNC Modification Rules Section 6.5.1(c) of the UNC.

Reason for Variation

During the consultation of Modification 0664V, concerns have been raised by Gazprom that under the consequences introduced under 0664V performance measures that a poorly performing supplier could impact a better performing supplier that was under the same shipper and that performance should be measured for each Shipper and Supplier relationship separately.

Nature of Variation

To amend Modification 0664V, to ensure that where a Shipper provides services for multiple Suppliers that the application of the Performance Measure should be at the Shipper level eg 90% of 25% target for read performance, may mean that a particular third party Supplier(s) performance may have an adverse impact on the other Supplier(s) using that same Shipper i.e. other Supplier SP's may be subject to sanction where in a Single Shipper and Supplier model they would not. Therefore, this variation seeks to ensure that the measure of performance is at the relevant Supplier level where the Shipper and Supplier are separate

Amendment of Business Rule 10 to state that the 90% portfolio target relates to each Shipper and Supplier combination and not solely to Shipper portfolios.

Current Business Rule

10. To allow for faulty meters and problematic sites any Shipper that achieves the Minimum Performance Measure for:

- a) at least [90%] of their Class 2 Supply Meter portfolio shall not be required to reclassify any existing Class 2 Supply Meters to Class 4
- b) at least [90%] of their Class 3 Supply Meter portfolio shall not be required to reclassify any existing Class 3 Supply Meters to Class 4"

Proposed Business Rule
