Extension of 6 months to 12 months to transfer non-mandatory sites from Class 1

Why change?



- Existing arrangements assumed a “lift and shift” of existing DM to Class 1 implementation
- Registered Users then had 6 months to transfer non mandatory Class 1 Supply Points
- Project Nexus implementation has created a number of issues with Class 1
- Xoserve led programme to address issues (4-6 weeks)
 - Solving one problem e.g. Asset issue has led to subsequent problems with reads loading

Solution



- Extend the existing 6 month window to 12 months
- Allows parties reasonable time to address issue
- Ensure SP's are correctly set up and running properly
- Then facilitate transfer to alternative arrangements

Recommended Steps



- The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:
 - Subject to self-governance
 - Workgroup assessment to develop the modification for 1 month
 - Proceed to consultation
