## 1.3. Review of outstanding Actions & Issues Log

**Update**: Ofgem (HBr) advised the Send Back process had been shared by Ofgem at the Distribution Workgroup meeting. TS asked if it could be published on the Governance Workgroup meeting page. YRH agreed the Joint Office would publish this. **Closed.** 

**Action 0202:** *Modification 0800*: Proposer (TS) to update the wording in the Modification to ensure it stipulates that Panel will consult once the derogation is in place.

**Update**: Tracey Saunders (TS) advised Modification 0800 would be reviewed under Agenda item 3.1. **Closed.** 

**Action 0203:** *Modification 0800:* Ofgem (HBr) to clarify what value is added by Panel making recommendation in the derogation process – what is the justification for Panel involvement.

**Update**: Ofgem (Harry Brazier (HBr)) advised that he had discussed this with TS and suggested that it was up to the UNC Modification Panel to decide on their involvement in the process. However, HBr suggested that any recommendations from Panel would be similar to Panel recommendations for Modifications and would take into account the collective knowledge and expertise of the Panel Members. **Closed.**

**Update**: YRH noted that KE had circulated an interpretation of the Voting Arrangements to the Workgroup Members who were also Panel Members and asked if there was any feedback.

TS was concerned that the current Panel Voting Arrangements are incorrect and suggested the correct rules should be implemented immediately (from the March 2022 Panel) or an explanation of the interpretation of the rules as they are now should be provided to Panel Members.

YRH agreed she would confirm that either the Panel voting arrangements would change or a written explanation of the current voting arrangements would be provided.

**New Action 0301:** Joint Office (YRH) to provide confirmation that the Panel Voting Arrangements will be updated and implemented immediately, or a written explanation of the current arrangements will be provided to all Panel Members.

#### Carried Forward.

**Action 0209:** Joint Office (HB) to raise at the next CACoP meeting and ask if it is worth considering using the same approach Government uses for documents.

**Update**: YRH advised that the next CACoP meeting had not yet take place and this will be raised when it does. **Carried Forward.**

# 4.1 Modification Panel Voting Arrangements

This was discussed under Action 0208. (haven't repeated the discussion as it was the same).

#### 4.2 Maintaining Legal Text for Modifications Awaiting Ofgem Decision

YRH advised that the Joint Office is proposing that the Legal Text providers should review the Legal Text of Modifications with Ofgem every six months to ensure that it remains relevant.

TS noted that Legal Text providers are unable to change the Legal Text for a Modification that is awaiting a decision from Ofgem, even if a change to the text can be identified. TS added that if a change to the text is required, Ofgem highlights this in their decision letter, allowing the industry to update the text prior to the Modification being implemented.

The Workgroup discussed this, and some Workgroup Members were of the opinion that until Ofgem issues a decision on a Modification, there is no benefit in reviewing the Legal Text.

YRH asked Ofgem (JS) for comments. JS stated she was unsure of the process and was unable to comment but agreed to provide a view on whether the Legal Text in a Modification can be amended whilst awaiting Ofgem's decision.

**New Action 0303:** Ofgem (JS) to provide a view on whether the Legal Text in a Modification can be amended whilst awaiting Ofgem's decision.

Mark Field (MF) asked if a Modification awaiting Ofgem's decision was amended to update the Legal Text, would it be pushed to the back of the queue adding to the time taken by Ofgem to make their decision.

**New Action 0304**: Ofgem (HBr) to advise whether a Modification awaiting Ofgem's decision would need additional time for a decision to be issued if it's Legal Text was updated.
