SSE supports Modification 0602A as it is necessary for cutover to the new Project Nexus arrangements and it maintains at least a 2 day window for objections for all days during the cutover period.

Modification 0602 does not maintain the minimum 2 day objection window for all days and also the requirements within it cannot be fully implemented by all parties without system changes at this late stage in the process, which would make a June 2017 Project Nexus implementation far less likely and successful should Modification 0602 be implemented.
