**Re: Urgent Modification Proposal 0169A**

Excelerate Energy does not support Modification 0169A

We believe that Modification 0169A (if implemented) could have a negative impact on the ability of gas shippers at Teesside to obtain additional NTS entry capacity by way of a transfer & trade mechanism.

Accordingly, on the grounds that we believe that Teesside's current Entry Capacity Baseline (set by GEMA's 30 March 2007 TPCR decision) is insufficient for the needs of its users, we oppose Modification 0169A.
