UNC Modifications 172 – Transporter Obligation Pertaining to Void and Vacant Sites

ScottishPower support the implementation of this Modification Proposal. Where a Large Transporter receives notification of a gas disconnection it is reasonable to expect that this information will be passed to the relevant Shipper within 10 Business Days of the disconnection being carried out. Receipt of this information will prompt the Shipper to formally withdraw from the Meter Point, therefore terminating energy and transportation charges.

We believe that this Modification will further the undernoted relevant objective: Standard Licence Condition A11.1 (d)

The removal of “dead” Meter Points will result in greater accuracy in energy and transportation costs allocations to Shippers. In addition data quality will be improved by ensuring that portfolio information is accurately recorded and maintained.
