Modification Proposal 0182 – Information Provision at LNG Importation Facilities

Thank you for allowing us to respond to this modification.

Scottish Power supports this modification

This modification seeks to establish what should be published should National Grid not receive some of the information required to comply with the aggregate publication requirement in the implemented mod proposal 0104.

We have some concerns over the commercially sensitive nature of the information if not published in aggregate and these concerns also apply to the information requirements outlined in the Third Energy package. This is subject to separate consultation/influence but we trust that stakeholders in the UK will be aware of this and the potential negative impact on the competitive market in the UK should this issue not be addressed.

Whilst we believe that an unknown quantity as outlined in the proposal would be preferable to a misleading quantity, ideally we would prefer the correct aggregated volumes. Therefore, we believe that the quality of information should be monitored to ensure that it doesn't degrade should this proposal be implemented.
