## Modification Proposal: 0184 Requirements for Partial Non-Business Days for the Purposes of the UK Link Technology Refresh (UKLTR) Project.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this Modification Proposal. Scotia Gas Networks supports implementation of this proposal.

Implementation of this proposal would allow for UK Link System Technology Refresh (UKLTR) to be upgraded, and in doing so will enable delivery of a dependable and robust set of UK Link Systems.

Application of 'partial Non-Business Days'; Monday 25<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2008; will permit Users to submit Supply Point Administration files during this period. These files will not, however, be processed during these two non- Business Days. It is hoped that xoserve will be able to process all files received during non-Business Days by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2008. It is recognised that the use of Non-Business days rather than non-effective days, as previously suggested; will reduce the impact on Users and xoserve, as non-effective days would have had to be stored and submitted after the non-effective days had passed.
