## EDF Energy Response to UNC Modification Proposal 0185 & 185A: "Meter Error Notification Process."

EDF Energy welcomes the opportunity to respond to these modification proposals. We support the implementation of both proposals.

Unfortunately following discussions with Wales and West Utilities regarding the legal text associated with this proposal, it has become clear that we will need to vary our proposal in the future. At a high level we propose to make the following variations:

- Vary proposal to include a reference within the UNC to clarify when the proposed guidelines should be followed.
- Vary the guidelines and proposal to provide clarification around the contractualisation of the MER and SMER.
- Vary the proposal to include the associated guidelines as UNC Related Documents.

We believe that the first variation is a material variation to our proposal, and following discussions we are intending to also incorporate changes to the OAD as proposed in alternate proposal 0185A. When the legal text associated with these changes is available we will make the formal variation to our modification and so intend to provide a more substantive response at a later date.

I hope this is acceptable and apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause. Please contact me should you wish to discuss these in greater detail.
