**Re: Proposed UNC Modification 0193 – “Removal of Certain “Gas Not Made Available for Offtake” Provisions from the UNC”**

Dear Julian,

RWE Npower supports Proposed UNC Modification 193. Regulation 7 of the “Gas (Standards of Performance) Regulations” obliges a Transporter to pay compensation to a customer at a Small Supply Point in the case where an unplanned interruption of supply takes place and supply is not restored within a certain predetermined time period.

This Regulation will essentially be an extension of the current UNC TPD Sections J3.5.2, J3.11.6(a) and V10 (e)(vi) which deal with a situation of this nature. As the Regulation will supersede the existing UNC provisions mentioned above, it seems logical that these should be removed from the UNC in order to avoid the possibility of potentially contradictory dual governance on this issue, particularly as the Statutory Instrument will be the primary authority in this case.
