Response to UNC Modification Proposal 0215: Enduring Arrangements for Supply Point Capacity decrease at an Interruptible Supply Point

The Proposal introduces an element of flexibility that enhances the existing business rules. This is achieved by allowing a User the option (subject to agreement with the transporter) to reflect changed consumption patterns at a consumer's premises, with associated modification to the firm/interruptible capacity split.

The amount of firm capacity at the site would be optimised thus freeing up spare capacity on the network.

In this circumstance the DN retains the interruptible capacity at the site and therefore wouldn't need to seek new capacity, should it still be required, via an 'ad hoc' tender. The cost of which would therefore be saved.

Consequently the Proposal supports the relevant objectives, specifically :

Standard Special Condition A11.1 the efficient and economic operation of the pipeline system.

E.ON UK supports this Proposal.
