<u>Re: UNC Modification Proposals 0220: "Invoicing Arrangements for Late Payments".</u>

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above proposals relating to the creation of a responsibility for the timely issuing of Interest Invoices. Corona Energy (CE) supports modification 220.

The UNC is currently mute on the timescales under which Interest Invoices must be raised. In situations where a credit payment is due to shippers this could create an incentive on Gas Transporters to process debit invoices quicker than credit invoices.

The implementation of this proposal will ensure failure to issue Interest Invoices in a timely manner would result in a breach of the UNC. Shipper's who experience inequitable treatment by a Gas Transporter would therefore have a route and mechanism to address this poor performance.

CE notes that the proposer has significantly revised and simplified this proposal following feedback from the Distribution Workstream. CE believes this has ensured that the proposal now provides a low cost solution to the problem, reflecting the relatively low level of materiality of the issue.
