Thank you for the opportunity to comment upon this Modification Proposal, I can confirm that we (WWU) are **supportive** of its implementation. We have nothing further to add to the justification for its implementation that is contained within the Modification Proposal.

We are not aware of any consequences of implementation other than the potential impact on CV Shrinkage (and the knock on of issues of FWACV). We do not believe these issues should prevent the amendments being made to this Entry Agreement as it is simply aligning the Gas Entry Conditions with those contained within Schedule 3 of the Gas Safety (Management) Regulations 1996 (as with other existing Entry Agreements).
