Modification Proposals 0256 – Amendment to the Network Entry Agreement at St Fergus SAGE Terminal

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above modification proposal. BP supports the implementation of this proposal.

The proposal seeks to align the Wobbe limits in the Network Entry Agreement at the SAGE terminal with those set out in the GS(M)R. BP agrees with the proposer that if implemented this proposal will allow a wider range of gas to be landed at the SAGE sub terminal at St Fergus thus adding to the security of supply.
