Implementation of this modification will better facilitate relevant objective A11.1(f) of the transporters' licence ("Promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the Code") as it will ensure that all existing Interruptible Supply Points become Firm Supply Points in the most efficient way. The additional back stop service, that will carried out by the Transporter Agency, ensures that where a Shipper is unable to complete the transition for any Interruptible Supply Point that this will not prevent the transition taking place.

The central system costs associated with the modification proposal will be paid for by the Gas Distribution Networks. As this is modification only applies to the transition period there will not be any ongoing costs.
