National Grid NTS submitted an initial representation on the 16th August 2011 requesting that NTS Exit Points be excluded from this Modification and we note that this has subsequently been done. National Grid NTS also highlighted that an additional change to the UNC Transition Document Part 11.4.6 would also be required and we are also happy to note that the Proposer has agreed to undertake this amendment. National Grid NTS recognises that this Modification may provide a number of benefits for both Distribution Networks and those Shippers with Daily Metered Supply Points within their Distribution Networks, but overall National Grid NTS is neutral regarding implementation of this Modification.
