Please summarise (in one paragraph) the key reason(s) for your support/opposition.

We support the implementation of this Modification Proposal as it should enhance the ability of parties to trade in the gas market, to better support forthcoming auctions in the power market. The OCM market currently opens at 12:00 on D-1 for day D whereas the Power auction for D runs before that. Without this Mod, generators may be unable to properly hedge their gas exposure particularly on non-working days. We note that some counterparties have stated that the lack of a "Day-Ahead Gas Price" on non-working days is a barrier to liquidity for the power market, in terms of their ability to trade out spark-related products on the auction. We support this Mod as it will provide a mechanism for people to provide that day-ahead gas price.
