The modification has been raised and developed on the basis of an Oct 1st 2015 implementation date as currently determined by Mod 432. Now that the Project Nexus Implementation Steering has recommended a delay to the delivery of the programme (with deferred elements delivery timescales are not clear) a revised implementation timescale is being investigated by the Programme Assurance Manager we would like more time to re-assess the modification with a view to understanding the impacts if the modification were implemented mid gas-year.

Implementation: *What lead-time do you wish to see prior to implementation and why?*

We would like to see the modification delayed until a new implementation date for Nexus is confirmed.

We don't have separate costs for transition activities over our main project costs.
