## Reason for support/opposition: reason(s)

As the proposer of this Modification, National Grid NTS supports implementation.

BBL Company has requested a change to the current Gas Entry Conditions within its Interconnection Agreement, as the instantaneous oxygen limit of 10ppm at the Bacton System Entry Point is not compatible with Dutch law, which requires all Interconnection Points (IP) in Holland to have an Oxygen limit of 10ppm as a 'daily average'. BBL Company believe that there is a potential risk that imported gas flows with a higher Oxygen content than 10ppm permitted to enter the BBL pipeline at Julianadorp may be rejected by National Grid NTS at Bacton.

BBL believes that increasing the current instantaneous limit of 10ppm to 200ppm via an enabling Modification, to facilitate the amendment within the Interconnection Agreement will remove the risk of gas flows exceeding their oxygen limit at Bacton.

National Grid NTS considers this to be a pragmatic solution.

National Grid NTS also believes that this Modification if implemented will better facilitate compliance with the Relevant Objective g) as it helps to demonstrate the general cooperation obligations between TSOs required under EU Regulation 715/2009.
